As a **Curriculum Resources writer**, you'll work under the direction of the Curriculum Resources Coordinator to contribute to the expanding suite of Australians Together curriculum resources. You'll be responsible for writing and refining curriculum resources and materials that are aligned with Australians Together's guidelines and that teachers will want to use.

You'll write curriculum resources that meet AITSL Teaching Standards 1.4 and 2.4 and that assist teachers to deliver the Australian Curriculum's Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Histories and Cultures cross-curriculum priority. You'll be writing for Foundation through to Year 6 across learning areas, often with a cross- or inter-disciplinary teaching and learning approach.

To ensure the accuracy and relevance of the resources, the role includes consultation with First Nations cultural experts as required.
